The Foundation „Regina Pacis” from the Republic of Moldova, is a public benefit, nonpolitical and non-commercial organization and aims to provide moral support, social assistance and reintegration of all that are in difficult situation and especially children on their own, men and women in need, trafficked women, poor people, emigrated Moldovan citizens.

The Mission of the Foundation is to contribute to solving complex problems of society by offering moral and material support, social assistance and reintegration of all those who are in difficult situation and especially children on their own, men and women in need, victims of human trafficking, poor people, emigrated Moldovan citizens, and by meeting conditions for their reintegration in society.

The Main Goals of the Foundation are as follows:

- Offering social assistance to poor people of any age by distributing humanitarian goods, hot meals and other things that can be necessary for an improvement of their living conditions;
- Offering social, psychological and medical assistance and counseling to minors who live in difficult conditions by placing them in homes-families, through their reintegration in origin families and in territorial institutions, by providing schooling and offering the necessary aid for their development;
- Offering legal assistance and legislative information for all assisted subjects;
- Carrying out, together with local and national authorities, as well as together with authorities of the European Union and European Council of various programs related to the goals and objectives of the Foundation.

Beneficiaries: invalids, victims of human trafficking, orphan children, homeless children, children from socially vulnerable families, mono-parental families, families of risk group, the elderly, young people, adolescents, teachers, parents, representatives of national minorities and people of various religious confessions.

The Legal Status of the Organization:

The Foundation „Regina Pacis” was founded on March 04th, 2001, registered by the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Moldova. The executive activity is carried out by the Executive Organ (Director). Book-keeping is ensured by an external company. The financial and economic activity is checked by the Audit Commission.

The Organization Team:

In the Foundation operates a team of specialists in domain of management, pedagogy, psychology, social assistance, medicine and engineering. At present, 25 persons work at the headquarters of the Foundation and its subdivisions, 6 of which are part-time employees. Beside the employees of the Foundation, there are also 8 persons who work as permanent volunteers. A group of volunteers- animators (about 80 people) work in the summer period.

On Work Experience of the Foundation „Regina Pacis”:

The Foundation undertakes the following activities:

- Medical and psychological assistance, counseling children deprived of parental care by the employees and specialists of the Centre of Placement of Children under the Foundation „Regina Pacis”. At present, 16 children deprived of parental care are placed at the Centre of Placement of Children „Regina Pacis”. Children are hosted at the Centre of Placement of Children in normal conditions as regards accommodation and food, general ambience, specialized relationships personnel - child, etc.;
- Offering material aid to children from families of risk group by ensuring schooling, kindergarten, payment for school and kindergarten, by ensuring periodic provision of food products, clothing, medicines, school supplies, as well as toys and gifts on the occasion of various holidays and children’s birthdays, by organizing their rest in summer camps, etc. At present, are assisted about 80 families of risk group.
- Offering assistance to persons in need, lonely old people, and invalids by providing them with hot meals at the Social Canteen from Chisinau and the village of Vărvăreuca, Florești district (around 250 beneficiaries). Periodic distribution of food products in package, clothing, footwear, medicines, etc. to persons in need;
- Carrying out programs aimed at preventing and informing large masses of young people and population about the risks of illegal emigration, as well as about the consequences of human trafficking; training of facilitators, and of volunteers from among adolescents and young people at risk, as well as of representatives and decision-makers from Local Public Administration units, etc.;
- Annual organization and holding of Summer Camps for children (around 700 children in the summer period) with participation of volunteers from Italy (Verona, Bologna, Trieste, Mantova, Torino, Lecce etc.);
- Free of charge editing and distribution of video and educational materials, as well as of newspaper articles about various programs carried out by the experts of the Foundation, as well as about the achievements of the Foundation, etc.

Thematic Campaigns:

- **Campaign to promote the young talents:**
National painting competition organized annually by the Foundation Regina Pacis in March. There will take part all art schools of Moldova including Transnistrian region and ATU Gagauzia.
- Carrying out Thematic Campaigns “Say NO to the Phenomenon of Trafficking of Human Beings!” with the main titles „Your Dignity is in Your Hands – Keep it!” and „Say NO to the Sex Tourism! Say YES to the Solidary Tourism!” with the financial support of the Ministry of Domestic Affairs of Italy, during the period of 2003 – 2006.
